We will travel by coach and ferry. Whilst in Cologne we will visit famous landmarks and the boys will be encouraged to use German as much as possible. The trip will include coach travel and accommodation in a youth centre, breakfast and evening meals. We plan to visit the chocolate factory, Cologne Cathedral and Phantasialand and entry fees to these attractions will also be included.
