Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to confirm your son's place on the Bronze Duke of Edinburgh's Award. As detailed at the launch evening and in the declarations on the sign-up form, keeping this place is dependent on good attendance and behaviour both within school and whilst on the award. Any student failing to meet our standards will be asked to leave the award.

The remainder of the fee due is **£90**, which needs to be paid using the **School Gateway App** by Thursday 28th March 2024. Instructions on how this can be done can be found on a separate sheet in this pack.

Your son should now be completing his **volunteering**, **skills** and **physical** sections. He is required to undertake an hour per week on each of his chosen activities, with **two sections lasting for 3 months and the other for 6 months**. For each of these, he needs to choose an **assessor** who will be in charge of his progress and write an assessment at the end of the activity. Examples of a suitable assessor would be a sports coach, a music tutor or a charity shop manager. <u>An assessor cannot be a member of the student's family</u>. Your son has been given a set of coloured cards, which are where details of weekly activities need to be logged. It is recommended you set aside a period of time each week to complete these, getting into a good routine to ensure they are kept up-to-date, with as much information about the activities as possible. He should also regularly take photographs of his activities, or of him taking part in them, as evidence. For example, pictures of him volunteering in a shop, examples of food cooked, or playing a sport.

Whilst your son needs to keeps a hard-copy record on the coloured sheets, he will also need to complete an online profile on the eDofE website, as this will be submitted on completion of the award. To do this, he needs to attend an after-school session in an ICT room, as detailed below.

During this session, your son will be completing personal details and information on his award sections, as well as being shown how to add evidence to his profile. It is essential he attends the session, as he will not be able to complete the award without doing so.

There will be further sessions on the eDofE website in the summer term, in order for students to complete their profile before they are submitted.
